Modern Governance for Competitive European Companies Debrief on Conference organised by MEDEF

On 16 and 17 October 2008, Laurence Parisot, President of France's leading employers' association, MEDEF, Christian Charrière-Bournazel, President of the Paris bar association and Jean-Martin Folz, President of the Association française des entreprises privées (AFEP), a French association of over 85 large companies operating in France, has held the 7th conference on "European corporate law and corporate governance" in Paris.

- the new balance of power within the Board of Directors;
- greater transparency during takeovers;
